

ACADEMIC IELTS PREPARATION

An international student applying to a Canadian university is required to meet English Language proficiency requirement. HHS's Academic IELTS preparation course aims to provide the students with the knowledge and skills necessary to successfully pass the IELTS exam with confidence. IELTS preparation program puts equal weight on listening, reading, writing, speaking and test taking strategies.

OSSD - GRADES 9 - 12 (OSSD)

In Ontario, students are required to attend secondary school until they have reached the age of eighteen or obtained their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). By the Curricula Guidelines of the Ontario Ministry of Education, students must earn a total of 30 credits from grade 9 to 12. HHS delivers a full range of courses varying between English, math, science, social studies, business, arts, etc.

UNIVERSITY PREPARATION PROGRAM (UPP) - GRADES 11 - 12

University Preparation Program is Hanson's high school program developed to equip students with the knowledge and skills that they need to meet the entrance requirements for university or college programs. Students who are considering to study in Canadian universities or colleges will benefit from this program as it is based on provincial curriculum expectations and emphasizes the development of both independent research skills and independent learning skills. Students enrolling into this program may need to take several Language Foundation ESL courses to improve their English skills required for the University Preparation Program.

UNIVERSITY GUARANTEE PROGRAM (UGP) - GRADE 12

University Guarantee Program is Hanson's premium high school program designed for international students who are serious about pursuing post-secondary studies in one of the top Canadian universities. It provides students with an accelerated pathway to enter university programs of their choice. Being the flagship program for Hanson International Academy, the UGP program provides students with dynamic and faster training to maximize students' academic potential. University Guarantee Program always has been in high demand by the students and the parents despite its limited seats.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT[®] (AP[®]) AP^* or Advanced Placement* is a trademark registered by the College Board

Advanced Placement[®] at Hanson offers high-level curricula and examinations to high school students. Qualified students can pursue university-level studies while in grade 12. Students may choose to demonstrate their understanding and application of the material studied in class by taking Advanced Placement examinations in May. AP exams are designed for motivated students that have a passion for the subject, and most students write AP exams for practical reasons. A student achieving a 4 out of 5 on the final AP exams may be considered for transfer credits when applying to a university.




Adam Hong Kong, China


